



SENATE MOTION

MR. PRESIDENT:

I move that Engrossed House Bill 1184 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 1, between the enacting clause and line 1, begin a new
2 paragraph and insert:
3 "SECTION 1. IC 9-22-1-27, AS AMENDED BY P.L.227-2025,
4 SECTION 20, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
5 JULY 1, 2026]: Sec. 27. (a) This section applies to sales of abandoned
6 vehicles or parts by a city, county, or town.
7 (b) The proceeds from the sale of abandoned vehicles or parts,
8 including:
9 (1) charges for bills of sale; and
10 (2) money received from persons who own or hold liens on
11 vehicles for the cost of removal or storage of vehicles;
12 shall **first** be credited against the costs of removal, storage, and
13 disposal of the vehicle **incurred by the towing company or storage**
14 **facility**. The remaining proceeds shall be deposited in the city's,
15 county's, or town's abandoned vehicle fund by the fiscal officer of the
16 city, county, or town.
17 (c) The costs incurred by a public agency in administering this
18 chapter shall be paid from the abandoned vehicle fund.
19 (d) The fiscal body shall annually appropriate sufficient money to
20 the fund to carry out this chapter. Money remaining in the fund at the
21 end of a year remains in the fund and does not revert to the general
22 fund.
23 (e) Notwithstanding subsection (d), the fiscal body of a consolidated
24 city may transfer money from the fund."
