### DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

**Citations Affected:** IC 6-2.5-15-15.

**Synopsis:** Labor requirements for data center incentives. Requires that an agreement between a qualified data center user or quantum computing research, advanced computing, and defense infrastructure network operator and the Indiana economic development corporation for a specific transaction award certificate includes a requirement that the user or operator limit bids or requests for proposals for the project to labor unions or employers that have project labor agreements.

**Effective:** July 1, 2026.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning taxation.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

1 SECTION 1. IC 6-2.5-15-15, AS AMENDED BY P.L.178-2025,  
2 SECTION 15, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE  
3 JULY 1, 2026]: Sec. 15. The following apply if the corporation  
4 approves an application for a specific transaction award certificate:

5 (1) The corporation shall require the qualified data center user or  
6 quantum computing research, advanced computing, and defense  
7 infrastructure network operator, as applicable, to enter into an  
8 agreement with the corporation as a condition of receiving a  
9 specific transaction award certificate under this chapter.

10 (2) The agreement with the corporation must include:  
11 (A) a detailed description of the project that is the subject of  
12 the agreement that includes documentation of compliance with  
13 the requirement that the investment be specific to  
14 infrastructure for the Indiana defense industry or quantum  
15 computing research or advanced computing;
