



SENATE MOTION

MR. PRESIDENT:

I move that Engrossed House Bill 1200 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 7, between lines 36 and 37, begin a new paragraph and insert:
2 "SECTION 8. IC 9-24-6.1-10, AS ADDED BY P.L.58-2017,
3 SECTION 1, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
4 UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 10. (a) As used in this section, "nondomiciled
5 commercial driver's license" means a commercial driver's license that
6 is issued to an individual who is domiciled:
7 (1) in a foreign country meeting the requirements of 49 CFR
8 383.23(b)(1); or
9 (2) in another state meeting the requirements of 49 CFR
10 383.23(b)(2).
11 (b) After December 31, 2017, the bureau shall issue a nondomiciled
12 commercial driver's license in accordance with 49 CFR 383.23 to an
13 individual who:
14 (1) submits a proper application under this article; and
15 (2) meets the requirements of 49 CFR 383.71(f).
16 (c) The bureau may create an application form or other required
17 documents to implement this section.
18 (d) The fee for a nondomiciled commercial driver's license is the
19 same as for a commercial driver's license under section 4 of this
20 chapter.
21 (e) A nondomiciled commercial driver's license is subject to the
22 same restrictions and requirements as a commercial driver's license
23 under this chapter.
24 **(f) Notwithstanding any other grounds for the revocation or**
25 **suspension of a commercial driver's license, the bureau shall**
26 **revoke an individual's nondomiciled commercial driver's license if**
27 **the bureau receives credible information, including information**

1 provided by the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration, the
 2 United States Department of Homeland Security, the United States
 3 Department of State, or another federal agency, that the
 4 individual:

- 5 (1) no longer has the legal status or documentation that were
 6 necessary at the time the individual's commercial driver's
 7 license was issued; or
 8 (2) poses a risk to public safety.

9 (g) Notwithstanding IC 9-33-2-1, an individual aggrieved by the
 10 bureau's revocation of the individual's nondomiciled commercial
 11 driver's license under subsection (f) may seek judicial review of the
 12 revocation through the judicial review procedures provided in
 13 IC 9-33-2-3.

14 (h) The bureau may not make a revocation under subsection (f)
 15 effective until the earlier of:

- 16 (1) fifteen (15) days after the individual receives notice of the
 17 revocation; or
 18 (2) the conclusion of a judicial review proceeding initiated
 19 under subsection (g).

20 (i) The bureau shall periodically consult with the United States
 21 Department of Homeland Security to identify individuals whose
 22 commercial driver's licenses may be subject to revocation under
 23 subsection (f).

24 (j) If an individual who received a nondomiciled commercial
 25 driver's license under this section:

- 26 (1) no longer has legal status under the federal Immigration
 27 and Nationality Act; and
 28 (2) is domiciled in a foreign country;

29 the individual's nondomiciled commercial driver's license expires
 30 on April 1, 2026.

 32 this section."
