



SENATE MOTION

MR. PRESIDENT:

I move that Engrossed House Bill 1200 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 4, between lines 17 and 18, begin a new paragraph and insert:
2 "SECTION 5. IC 9-21-5-12, AS AMENDED BY P.L.49-2024,
3 SECTION 12, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
4 UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 12. (a) Except as provided in ~~subsection (d),~~
5 **subsections (d) and (e)**, whenever the Indiana department of
6 transportation determines on the basis of an engineering and traffic
7 investigation that a maximum speed set forth in this chapter is greater
8 or less than is reasonable or safe under the conditions found to exist at
9 an intersection or other place or on part of the state highway system,
10 the Indiana department of transportation may determine and declare a
11 reasonable and safe maximum limit at the intersection or on the part of
12 the state highway system. The differing limit is effective when
13 appropriate signs giving notice of the limit are erected.
14 (b) A maximum speed limit under this section may be declared to
15 be effective at all times or at times indicated on the signs. Differing
16 limits may be established for different times of day **and** different types
17 of vehicles. ~~varying weather conditions, and other factors bearing on~~
18 ~~safe speeds~~. The differing limits are effective when posted on
19 appropriate fixed ~~or variable~~ signs.
20 (c) A person who exceeds a speed limit established under this
21 section commits a Class C infraction.
22 (d) The Indiana department of transportation may decrease the
23 speed limit on a highway in its jurisdiction with a functional
24 classification of minor collector or local road in an urban district to
25 twenty (20) miles per hour without an engineering and traffic
26 investigation.
27 **(e) The Indiana department of transportation may not:**

- 1 **(1) implement variable speed limits; or**
- 2 **(2) use electronic variable speed limit signs."**
- 3 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
