



# SENATE MOTION

**MR. PRESIDENT:**

**I move** that Engrossed House Bill 1200 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 6, line 41, after "Sec. 2.7." insert "(a)".
- 2 Page 7, between lines 7 and 8, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 3 "**(b) An individual must take and pass a skills exam in English**
- 4 **to operate a commercial motor vehicle.**".
- 5 Page 7, between lines 36 and 37, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 6 "SECTION 8. IC 9-24-6.1-10, AS ADDED BY P.L.58-2017,
- 7 SECTION 1, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
- 8 UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 10. (a) As used in this section, "nondomiciled
- 9 commercial driver's license" means a commercial driver's license that
- 10 is issued to an individual who is domiciled:
- 11 (1) in a foreign country meeting the requirements of 49 CFR
- 12 383.23(b)(1); or
- 13 (2) in another state meeting the requirements of 49 CFR
- 14 383.23(b)(2).
- 15 (b) After December 31, 2017, the bureau shall issue a nondomiciled
- 16 commercial driver's license in accordance with 49 CFR 383.23 to an
- 17 individual who:
- 18 (1) submits a proper application under this article; and
- 19 (2) meets the requirements of 49 CFR 383.71(f).
- 20 (c) The bureau may create an application form or other required
- 21 documents to implement this section.
- 22 (d) The fee for a nondomiciled commercial driver's license is the
- 23 same as for a commercial driver's license under section 4 of this
- 24 chapter.
- 25 (e) A nondomiciled commercial driver's license is subject to the
- 26 same restrictions and requirements as a commercial driver's license
- 27 under this chapter.

1           **(f) A nondomiciled commercial driver's license may only be**  
2 **issued to an individual if the individual meets:**  
3           **(1) all requirements described in section 2 of this chapter; and**  
4           **(2) any other requirements for the holder of a commercial**  
5 **driver's license or commercial learner's permit required by**  
6 **state law or administrative law.**  
7           ~~(f)~~ **(g) The bureau may adopt rules under IC 4-22-2 to implement**  
8 **this section.**  
9           **(h) In addition to any grounds for suspension or revocation, the**  
10 **bureau shall, consistent with federal law, revoke an individual's**  
11 **nondomiciled commercial driver's license upon receipt of credible**  
12 **information, including information provided by the Federal Motor**  
13 **Carrier Safety Administration, the United States Department of**  
14 **Homeland Security, the United States Department of State, or any**  
15 **other federal agency, that the individual:**  
16           **(1) is an unauthorized alien as defined by 8 U.S.C.**  
17 **1324a(h)(3);**  
18           **(2) no longer possesses an unexpired foreign passport; or**  
19           **(3) no longer possesses a form I-94/94A issued by the United**  
20 **States Department of Homeland Security with an unexpired**  
21 **admit until date indicating one (1) of the following**  
22 **classifications:**  
23           **(A) A H-2A-Temporary Agricultural Workers**  
24 **classification.**  
25           **(B) A H-2B-Temporary Non-Agricultural Workers**  
26 **classification.**  
27           **(C) An E-2-Treaty Investors classification.**  
28 **This subsection applies regardless of whether the individual was**  
29 **eligible to receive a nondomiciled commercial driver's license at**  
30 **the time the license was issued."**  
31           Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
