



# SENATE MOTION

**MR. PRESIDENT:**

**I move** that Engrossed House Bill 1200 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 6, line 41, after "2.7." insert "(a)".
- 2 Page 7, between lines 7 and 8, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 3 "**(b) The bureau must offer a knowledge exam under this**
- 4 **chapter only in the English language.**".
- 5 Page 7, between lines 36 and 37, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 6 "SECTION 8. IC 9-24-6.1-10, AS ADDED BY P.L.58-2017,
- 7 SECTION 1, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
- 8 UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 10. (a) As used in this section, "nondomiciled
- 9 commercial driver's license" means a commercial driver's license that
- 10 is issued to an individual who is domiciled:
- 11 (1) in a foreign country meeting the requirements of 49 CFR
- 12 383.23(b)(1); or
- 13 (2) in another state meeting the requirements of 49 CFR
- 14 383.23(b)(2).
- 15 (b) After December 31, 2017, **and except as provided in section**
- 16 **10.1 of this chapter**, the bureau shall issue a nondomiciled commercial
- 17 driver's license in accordance with 49 CFR 383.23 to an individual
- 18 who:
- 19 (1) submits a proper application under this article; and
- 20 (2) meets the requirements of 49 CFR 383.71(f).
- 21 (c) The bureau may create an application form or other required
- 22 documents to implement this section.
- 23 (d) The fee for a nondomiciled commercial driver's license is the
- 24 same as for a commercial driver's license under section 4 of this
- 25 chapter.
- 26 (e) A nondomiciled commercial driver's license is subject to the

1 same restrictions and requirements as a commercial driver's license  
2 under this chapter.  
3 (f) The bureau may adopt rules under IC 4-22-2 to implement this  
4 section.  
5 SECTION 9. IC 9-24-6.1-10.1 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA  
6 CODE AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS  
7 [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE]: **Sec. 10.1. The bureau may not**  
8 **administer a knowledge exam for the issuance of a commercial**  
9 **driver's license or nondomiciled commercial driver's license to an**  
10 **individual who:**  
11 **(1) has a pending or approved application for asylum; or**  
12 **(2) has refugee status."**  
13 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
