

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

HB 1200 # 14

DIGEST

Commercial motor vehicles. Provides that an individual commits a Level 6 felony if the individual: (1) represents that a false record is a valid commercial driver's license; or (2) does not have proper documentation while driving with a commercial driver's license issued by any jurisdiction other than a state, territory, or possession of the United States. Establishes civil penalties for the individual and the carrier of the commercial motor vehicle.

- 1 Page 6, between lines 3 and 4, begin a new paragraph and insert:
2 "SECTION 6. IC 9-24-6.1-3.3 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA
3 CODE AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS
4 [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE]: **Sec. 3.3. (a) If an individual:**
5 **(1) makes, presents, or uses a public record with knowledge of**
6 **the falsity of the public record and with the intent that the**
7 **public record be taken as genuine; and**
8 **(2) represents that a false public record made, presented, or**
9 **used is a valid commercial driver's license under section 3 of**
10 **this chapter;**
11 **the individual commits a Level 6 felony.**
12 **(b) If an individual knowingly:**
13 **(1) holds a commercial driver's license that was issued by any**
14 **jurisdiction other than a state, territory, or possession of the**
15 **United States; and**
16 **(2) does not have the additional entry documents required**
17 **under 8 CFR 214.2(b)(4) in the individual's possession while**
18 **operating a commercial motor vehicle;**
19 **the individual commits a Level 6 felony.**
20 **(c) If an individual violates subsection (a) or (b), in addition to**
21 **the criminal penalties, the following apply:**
22 **(1) The individual is subject to a civil penalty of five thousand**
23 **dollars (\$5,000).**
24 **(2) The carrier (as defined in IC 6-6-4.1-1(a)) of the**
25 **commercial motor vehicle the individual was operating at the**

1 **time of the violation is subject to a civil penalty of fifty**
2 **thousand dollars (\$50,000). This subdivision applies to a**
3 **commercial motor vehicle leased to a carrier to the same**
4 **extent and in the same manner as a commercial motor vehicle**
5 **owned by the carrier."**

6 Page 15, between lines 14 and 15, begin a new paragraph and insert:
7 "SECTION 16. IC 35-52-9.1-30.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA
8 CODE AS A **NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS**
9 **[EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 30.5. IC 9-24-6.1-3.3 defines**
10 **a crime concerning commercial motor vehicles."**

11 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
