MR. SPEAKER:

Your Committee on **Roads and Transportation**, to which was referred House Bill 1200, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the House with the recommendation that said bill **be amended** as follows:

- 1 Page 1, delete lines 1 through 11.
- 2 Page 3, between lines 11 and 12, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 3 **"(d) A license plate issued under this chapter that is designed in**
- 4 **an alternate color scheme version is subject to the fee described in**
- 5 **IC 9-18.5-2-8(3).**
- 6 SECTION 4. IC 9-19-12-1 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
- 7 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2026]: Sec. 1. A motor vehicle that
- 8 is constructed or loaded so as to obstruct the driver's view to the rear
- 9 from the driver's position must be equipped with **either:**
- 10 **(1) a mirror located so as to reflect to the driver a view of the**
- 11 highway for a distance of at least two hundred (200) feet to the
- 12 rear of the vehicle; **or**
- 13 **(2) an appropriate, functioning rear view camera that**
- 14 **provides the driver a view of the highway for a distance of at**

- 1 **least two hundred (200) feet to the rear of the vehicle."**
 2 Page 3, delete lines 12 through 20.
 3 Page 15, between lines 5 and 6, begin a new paragraph and insert:
 4 "SECTION 15. IC 24-4-26-1 IS REPEALED [EFFECTIVE JULY
 5 1, 2026]. Sec. 1. This chapter does not apply to the advertisement of a:
 6 (1) product containing marijuana; or
 7 (2) controlled substance listed in schedule I of IC 35-48-2;
 8 pursuant to a contract that was entered into or renewed before the
 9 effective date of this chapter as enacted by the 2025 general assembly.
 10 SECTION 16. IC 24-4-26-4, AS ADDED BY P.L.227-2025,
 11 SECTION 41, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
 12 JULY 1, 2026]: Sec. 4. (a) A person may not advertise a:
 13 (1) product containing marijuana; or
 14 (2) controlled substance listed in schedule I of IC 35-48-2;
 15 by any medium.
 16 **(b) An advertisement in violation of subsection (a) must be**
 17 **removed from public circulation and not available to be viewed by**
 18 **the public not later than October 1, 2026."**
 19 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
 (Reference is to HB 1200 as introduced.)
