



COMMITTEE REPORT

MR. PRESIDENT:

The Senate Committee on Homeland Security and Transportation, to which was referred House Bill No. 1200, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the Senate with the recommendation that said bill be AMENDED as follows:

- 1 Page 1, between the enacting clause and line 1, begin a new
2 paragraph and insert:
3 "SECTION 1. IC 9-18.1-5-12, AS AMENDED BY P.L.63-2025,
4 SECTION 1, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
5 JULY 1, 2026]: Sec. 12. (a) The supplemental fee in this section
6 applies after December 31, 2017, to each electric vehicle and hybrid
7 vehicle that is required to be registered under this article. The
8 supplemental fee in this section does not apply to vehicles subject to
9 the motor carrier fuel tax under IC 6-6-4.1, **low speed vehicles**, or
10 motor driven cycles.
11 (b) As used in this section, "electric vehicle" means a vehicle that:
12 (1) is propelled by an electric motor powered by a battery or other
13 electrical device incorporated into the vehicle; and
14 (2) is not propelled by an engine powered by the combustion of
15 a hydrocarbon fuel, including gasoline, diesel, propane, or liquid
16 natural gas.
17 (c) As used in this section, "hybrid vehicle" means a vehicle that:
18 (1) draws propulsion energy from both an internal combustion

1 engine and an energy storage device; and
 2 (2) employs a regenerative braking system to recover waste
 3 energy to charge the energy storage device that is providing
 4 propulsion energy.

5 (d) In addition to any other fee required to register an electric
 6 vehicle under this chapter, the supplemental fee to register an electric
 7 vehicle is one hundred fifty dollars (\$150). The bureau shall determine
 8 a new fee amount to take effect as of January 1 of the following year by
 9 determining the product of the following:

- 10 (1) Before October 1, 2023:
 11 (A) the fee in effect for the determination year; multiplied by
 12 (B) the factor determined under IC 6-6-1.6-2(b).
 13 (2) Before October 1 of each year thereafter:
 14 (A) the fee in effect for the determination year; multiplied by
 15 (B) the factor determined under IC 6-6-1.6-3.

16 The fee shall be rounded to the nearest dollar.

17 (e) In addition to any other fee required to register a hybrid vehicle
 18 under this chapter, the supplemental fee to register a hybrid vehicle is
 19 fifty dollars (\$50). The bureau shall determine a new fee amount to
 20 take effect as of January 1 of the following year by determining the
 21 product of the following:

- 22 (1) Before October 1, 2023:
 23 (A) the fee in effect for the determination year; multiplied by
 24 (B) the factor determined under IC 6-6-1.6-2(b).
 25 (2) Before October 1 of each year thereafter:
 26 (A) the fee in effect for the determination year; multiplied by
 27 (B) the factor determined under IC 6-6-1.6-3.

28 The fee shall be rounded to the nearest dollar.

29 (f) The fee shall be deposited in the local road and bridge matching
 30 grant fund established by IC 8-23-30-2."

31 Page 6, between lines 3 and 4, begin a new paragraph and insert:

32 "SECTION 7. IC 9-24-6.1-3.3 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA
 33 CODE AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS
 34 [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE]: **Sec. 3.3. (a) If an individual:**

- 35 **(1) makes, presents, or uses a public record with knowledge of**
 36 **the falsity of the public record and with the intent that the**
 37 **public record be taken as genuine; and**
 38 **(2) represents that a false public record made, presented, or**

1 used is a valid commercial driver's license under section 3 of
2 this chapter;
3 the individual commits a Level 6 felony.

4 **(b) If an individual knowingly:**
5 **(1) holds a commercial driver's license that was issued by any**
6 **jurisdiction other than a state, territory, or possession of the**
7 **United States; and**
8 **(2) does not have the additional entry documents required**
9 **under 8 CFR 214.2(b)(4) in the individual's possession while**
10 **operating a commercial motor vehicle;**
11 the individual commits a Level 6 felony.

12 **(c) If an individual violates subsection (a) or (b), in addition to**
13 **the criminal penalties, the following apply:**

- 14 **(1) The individual is subject to a civil penalty of five thousand**
15 **dollars (\$5,000).**
16 **(2) The carrier (as defined in IC 6-6-4.1-1(a)) of the**
17 **commercial motor vehicle the individual was operating at the**
18 **time of the violation is subject to a civil penalty of fifty**
19 **thousand dollars (\$50,000). This subdivision applies to a**
20 **commercial motor vehicle leased to a carrier to the same**
21 **extent and in the same manner as a commercial motor vehicle**
22 **owned by the carrier."**

23 Page 15, line 14, delete "July 1, 2026." and insert "**October 1,**
24 **2026.**". Page 15, between lines 14 and 15, begin a new paragraph and
25 insert:

26 "SECTION 17. IC 35-52-9.1-30.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA
27 CODE AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS
28 [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE]: **Sec. 30.5. IC 9-24-6.1-3.3 defines**

- 1 **a crime concerning commercial motor vehicles."**
- 2 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.

and when so amended that said bill do pass.
