Summary of Legislation: The bill provides a price preference to a business that is not an Indiana business but offers to provide supplies manufactured, assembled, or produced in Indiana. The bill provides that an Indiana business that offers to provide supplies manufactured, assembled, or produced in Indiana is eligible for an additional price preference for a contract awarded by a state agency. (Under current law, the additional price preference applies only when two or more equal bids are submitted.)

Effective Date: July 1, 2026.

Explanation of State Expenditures: By removing the condition of equal bids from one or more non-Indiana business, and adding Indiana businesses providing supplies originating in Indiana for additional price preference to the probability would increase for an Indiana business to qualify for the additional price preferences within current law on the sale of supplies manufactured, assembled, or produced in Indiana to a state agency. As a result, state expenditures may increase slightly in future state fiscal years.
