IMPACT: State

Summary of Legislation: This bill requires the Indiana Department of Health (IDOH) to establish state maximum contaminant levels for PFAS in water provided by public water systems. It provides that maximum contaminant levels established by IDOH: (1) must be protective of public health, including the health of vulnerable subpopulations; and (2) may not be less stringent than any maximum contaminant level or health advisory promulgated by the United States Environmental Protection Agency.

Effective Date: July 1, 2026.

Explanation of State Expenditures: The bill will increase workload for IDOH to adopt rules establishing maximum contaminant levels for PFAS in water provided by public water systems. This should be able to be implemented using existing staffing and resources. *[The IDOH's administrative expenditures are currently paid from the Tobacco Master Settlement Fund, a dedicated fund.]*
