HOUSE BILL No. 1242

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning education.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 20-19-3-41.3 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA
2 CODE AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS
3 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2026]: **Sec. 41.3. (a) The department shall**
4 **prepare a report compiling statewide data on school corporations**
5 **and charter schools. The report must include the following**
6 **information:**
7 (1) **The total number of school corporations and charter**
8 **schools in Indiana disaggregated by:**
9 (A) **county population;**
10 (B) **the number of school corporations and charter**
11 **schools per county; and**
12 (C) **the number of students enrolled in each school**
13 **corporation and charter school.**
14 (2) **Recommendations to:**
15 (A) **increase school corporation and charter school**

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- 1 administrative efficiencies; and
2 (B) reduce school corporation and charter school
3 administrative costs.
4 (b) Not later than September 1, 2026, the department shall, in
5 an electronic format under IC 5-14-6, submit the report prepared
6 under subsection (a) to the:
7 (1) legislative council; and
8 (2) interim study committee on education established by
9 IC 2-5-1.3-4.
10 (c) This section expires December 31, 2026.

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
