HOUSE BILL No. 1242

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning education.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 20-19-3-41.3 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA
2 CODE AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS
3 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2026]: **Sec. 41.3. (a) As used in this section,**
4 **"eligible school" has the meaning set forth in IC 20-51-1-4.7.**

5 **(b) The department shall prepare a report compiling statewide**
6 **data on school corporations, charter schools, and eligible schools.**
7 **The report must include the following information:**

8 **(1) The total number of school corporations, charter schools,**
9 **and eligible schools in Indiana disaggregated by:**

10 **(A) county population;**

11 **(B) the number of school corporations, charter schools,**
12 **and eligible schools per county; and**

13 **(C) the number of students enrolled in each school**
14 **corporation, charter school, and eligible school.**
