HOUSE BILL No. 1242

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning education.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 20-19-3-41.3 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA
2 CODE AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS
3 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2026]: **Sec. 41.3. (a) The department shall**
4 **prepare a report compiling statewide data on school corporations.**
5 **The report must include the following information:**
6 (1) **The total number of school corporations in Indiana**
7 **disaggregated by:**
8 (A) **county population;**
9 (B) **the number of school corporations per county; and**
10 (C) **the number of students enrolled in each school**
11 **corporation.**
12 (2) **Data regarding chronic absenteeism rates, performance**
13 **on the statewide assessment program, performance on the**
14 **determinant evaluation of reading skills approved by the**
15 **state board, and teacher salaries, disaggregated by:**

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- 1 (A) county population;
2 (B) the number of school corporations per county; and
3 (C) the number of students enrolled in each school
4 corporation.
5 (3) Recommendations to:
6 (A) increase school corporation administrative
7 efficiencies;
8 (B) reduce school corporation administrative costs; and
9 (C) improve student outcomes.
10 (b) Not later than December 1, 2026, the department shall, in
11 an electronic format under IC 5-14-6, submit the report prepared
12 under subsection (a) to the:
13 (1) legislative council; and
14 (2) interim study committee on education established by
15 IC 2-5-1.3-4.
16 (c) This section expires December 31, 2026.

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
