HB 1303 # 7

DIGEST

High risk missing person. Adds "high risk missing person" to the definition of "missing child".

- 1 Page 4, between lines 10 and 11, begin a new paragraph and insert:
2 "SECTION 3. IC 10-13-5-4 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
3 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2026]: Sec. 4. As used in this
4 chapter, "missing child" means a person less than eighteen (18) years
5 of age who:
6 (1) is, or is believed to be:
7 (A) a temporary or permanent resident of Indiana;
8 (B) at a location that cannot be determined by the person's
9 parent or legal custodian; and
10 (C) reported missing to a law enforcement agency; ~~or~~
11 (2) is, or is believed to be:
12 (A) a temporary or permanent resident of Indiana; and
13 (B) a victim of the offense of criminal confinement (IC
14 35-42-3-3) or interference with custody (IC 35-42-3-4); **or**
15 **(3) is, or is believed to be a high risk missing person (as**
16 **defined by IC 5-2-17-1)."**
17 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
