**Summary of Legislation:** This bill allows the Inspector General to receive complaints regarding violations of the Indiana grain buyers and warehouse licensing and bonding Law by the director of the Indiana Grain Buyers and Warehouse Licensing Agency (IGBWLA).

The bill reorganizes the existing statute regarding grain shortages, claims, and payments.

The bill provides for certain notices to be included in contracts for the purchase of grain.

The bill requires an administrative law judge to award reasonable attorney's fees to the claimant in certain administrative adjudications.

It also makes conforming and technical corrections.
