Summary of Legislation: This bill defines "aggravated child molesting". It provides that the state may seek either a death sentence or a sentence of life imprisonment without parole for a person convicted of aggravated child molesting. It provides requirements for a jury or court to impose either a death sentence or a sentence of life imprisonment without parole. It also makes conforming changes.
