

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

HB 1315 # 3

DIGEST

Fire protection territories and districts. Provides that a township that participates in a fire protection territory (territory) or fire protection district (district) does not operate a fire department for purposes of the bill. Provides that after a reorganization: (1) the area within the boundaries of the dissolved township remains in the district; and (2) the designated unit succeeds the dissolved township in its role in the territory or district.

21 **township in the township's role as:**
22 (A) provider unit or nonprovider unit in the fire protection
23 territory; or
24 (B) participant in the fire protection district;
25 **for the area within the boundaries of the dissolved township."**
