**Summary of Legislation:** This bill prohibits the exclusion of otherwise admissible evidence based on a violation of the Constitution of the State of Indiana, the Constitution of the United States, or the laws of the United States or Indiana unless certain conditions apply. It provides that an appeal from a court's order excluding evidence may be taken directly to the Supreme Court.

**Effective Date:** July 1, 2026.
