Summary of Legislation: This bill requires a food manufacturer that offers certain food products for sale in Indiana to ensure that each food product includes a warning label disclosing specified ingredients in the food product. It sets forth labeling requirements. It also allows the Attorney General to bring an action for a violation of these provisions.

Effective Date: July 1, 2026.

Explanation of State Expenditures: Beginning FY 2028, this bill may increase workload and expenditures for the Attorney General to bring an action against a food manufacturer that violates the food labeling requirements established in the bill, but should be able to be implemented using existing staffing and resources.

Explanation of State Revenues: The Attorney General may impose a civil penalty of up to \$50,000 per day for each violation of the food labeling requirements established in the bill, and may obtain reasonable costs of investigating the violation and maintaining the action. Revenue from the civil penalties will be deposited into the state General Fund.
