

HOUSE BILL No. 1380

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 1-1-11-3.

Synopsis: Women veteran recognition day. Provides that the governor shall issue a proclamation annually setting apart and designating June 12 as Women Veteran Recognition Day.

Effective: Upon passage.

HOUSE BILL No. 1380

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning general provisions.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 1-1-11-3 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
2 AS A **NEW SECTION** TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
3 UPON PASSAGE]: **Sec. 3. The governor shall issue a proclamation**
4 **annually setting apart and designating June 12 as Women Veteran**
5 **Recognition Day, and recommending in the proclamation that the**
6 **day be observed by the people in celebrating the many**
7 **contributions of women to our military forces.**

8 SECTION 2. **An emergency is declared for this act.**
