DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 1-1-11-3.

Synopsis: Women veteran recognition day. Provides that the governor shall issue a proclamation annually setting apart and designating June 12 as Women Veteran Recognition Day.

Effective: Upon passage.

HOUSE BILL No. 1380

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning general provisions.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 1-1-11-3 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
- 2 AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
- 3 UPON PASSAGE]: **Sec. 3. The governor shall issue a proclamation**
- 4 **annually setting apart and designating June 12 as Women Veteran**
- 5 **Recognition Day, and recommending in the proclamation that the**
- 6 **day be observed by the people in celebrating the many**
- 7 **contributions of women to our military forces.**
- 8 SECTION 2. An emergency is declared for this act.
