Summary of Legislation: This bill allows the legislative body of a city or town (municipality) to petition a court for removal of the municipality's fiscal officer for any of the following:

- (1) Charging illegal fees for services.
- (2) Failing to perform official duties.
- (3) With certain exceptions, failing to be present in the officer's office.
- (4) Failing to participate in four consecutive meetings of the legislative body of the municipality.

Effective Date: July 1, 2026.

Explanation of Local Expenditures: This bill's provisions would cause a minor administrative workload increase for legislative bodies to petition a court to remove the municipality's fiscal officer and hold at least one public hearing. A new fiscal officer will likely be chosen from the prior officer's party caucus and the new officer will earn the salary provided by local statute so no other fiscal impacts are likely to occur.
