

HOUSE BILL No. 1395

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 16-28-2-13.

Synopsis: Hospice care. Prohibits a health facility from including in a contract entered into, renewed, or amended after June 30, 2026, a provision prohibiting a person from transferring a resident to a different facility for hospice care.

Effective: July 1, 2026.

HOUSE BILL No. 1395

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning health.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 16-28-2-13 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
2 AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
3 1, 2026]: **Sec. 13. A health facility may not include in a contract**
4 **entered into, renewed, or amended after June 30, 2026, a provision**
5 **that prohibits a person from transferring a resident to a different**
6 **facility for hospice care.**
