**Summary of Legislation:** This bill requires the Indiana Department of Health (IDOH) to prepare an annual report with specified statistics that compare data from 2021 before abortion restrictions were enacted with data from each subsequent calendar year.

**Effective Date:** July 1, 2026.

**Explanation of State Expenditures:** This bill will increase workload for the IDOH to create, in collaboration with the Family and Social Services Administration, Department of Child Services, the Professional Licensing Agency, and the Statewide Maternal Mortality Review Committee, an annual report on maternal and infant health, as specified in the bill. To the extent that the required information is already collected by IDOH or other state agencies, increases to workload may be mitigated. This should be able to be implemented with existing staff and resources. *[The IDOH's administrative expenditures are currently paid from the Tobacco Master Settlement Fund, a dedicated fund. The Statewide Maternal Mortality Review Committee is supported by federal grant funding.]*
