## HOUSE MOTION \_\_\_\_\_

MR. SPEAKER:

I move that House Bill 1417 be amended to read as follows:

1       Page 1, between the enacting clause and line 1, begin a new  
2       paragraph and insert:

3       "SECTION 1. IC 8-3-1-20.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE  
4       AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY  
5       1, 2026]: Sec. 20.5. (a) As used in this section, "personally  
6       identifying information" means the following information that  
7       identifies an individual:

- 8           (1) Name.
- 9           (2) Driver's license number.
- 10          (3) Address (other than the ZIP code).
- 11          (4) Date of birth.
- 12          (5) Height.
- 13          (6) Weight.
- 14          (7) Hair color.
- 15          (8) Eye color.
- 16          (9) Electronic mail address.
- 17          (10) Telephone number.

18       The term does not include information about vehicular accidents,  
19       driving or equipment related violations, and driver's license or  
20       registration status.

21       (b) Personally identifying information of railroad crew

1       members must be redacted from any public report involving a  
2       railroad fatality.

3       (c) Any law enforcement agency or other person who possesses  
4       a report involving a railroad fatality shall maintain the report in  
5       a manner that ensures the confidentiality of the railroad crew's  
6       personally identifying information.

7       (d) An unredacted copy of a report involving a railroad fatality  
8       must be accessible at all reasonable times:

9           (1) to the host or employing railroad;

10           (2) by a court order;

11           (3) to a person specifically authorized by a court order to  
12           obtain the information if access to the information is  
13           necessary in the performance of the duties of the person; and

14           (4) to:

15              (A) law enforcement officers;

16              (B) the attorney general;

17              (C) the attorney general's deputies and assistants;

18              (D) the department; and

19              (E) the department's staff;

20       if access to the information is necessary in the performance of  
21       the duties of a person described in clauses (A) through (E).".

22       Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
