IMPACT: State & Local

Summary of Legislation: This bill provides that certain individuals seeking an initial practitioner license are exempt from certain licensing requirements.

Effective Date: July 1, 2026.

Explanation of State Expenditures: Beginning in FY 2027, the bill prohibits the initial practitioner license from requiring pedagogy examinations for certain applicants. The workload of the Department of Education (DOE) would increase if the agency reviews more licenses.

Explanation of State Revenues: The Professional Standards Fund will experience a revenue increase of \$36.72 for each additional initial practitioner license reviewed by DOE as a result of the bill's provisions.

Explanation of Local Expenditures: If the number of licensed teachers increases as a result of the bill's provisions, school corporations may be able to fill vacant positions.
