**IMPACT:** State & Local

**Summary of Legislation:** The bill requires practitioners who perform gender transition procedures to report on a quarterly basis certain information to the practitioner's regulating board concerning the gender transition procedures. The bill requires the submitted reports to be provided to the Professional Licensing Agency (PLA) to be compiled as an annual report. The bill requires the PLA to post the annual report on the PLA's website and submit the report to the General Assembly.

**Effective Date:** July 1, 2026.

**Explanation of State Expenditures:** The bill will increase workload on the PLA and certain professional boards within the PLA, but each should be able to compile the data and produce the quarterly reports using existing staff and resources. The PLA currently produces heath workforce reports and annual reports on professional licences.
