1 A HOUSE RESOLUTION celebrating the 70th anniversary 2 of the Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc., South Bend Chapter.

Whereas, Delta Sigma Theta, Incorporated, was founded nationally on January 13, 1913, on the campus of Howard University by 22 young women who had a calling to make a difference, particularly in the Black community;

Whereas, Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc., is a private, not-for-profit organization whose purpose is to provide assistance and support through established programs in local communities worldwide. The sorority currently has over 1,000 collegiate and alumnae chapters located in over 11 countries;

Whereas, The South Bend Alumnae Chapter of Delta Sigma
Theta Sorority, Inc., was the first Black Greek letter
organization in the Michiana area. It was initially chartered as

the Epsilon Mu Sigma chapter on December 3, 1955, at the 1 historic LaSalle Hotel in South Bend by nine women who were 2 part of a local group called the Sorors Club; 3 Whereas, The Sorors Club was known for its successes in 4 community service, education, and social endeavors and its 5 members were enthusiastic and steadfast about continuing that 6 work while serving the South Bend community; 8 Whereas, The charter members of Epsilon Mu Sigma (now known as the South Bend Alumnae Chapter) were Kitty 9 10 Bowden-Smith, Joyce Brown-Stith (President), June Brown-Locke (Treasurer), Audrey Elliott-Vagner (Secretary), 11 Peggy Flowers-Eskridge, Theresa Harrison-Ashe, Goldie Ivory, 12 Frances Poindexter-Dixon, and Marjorie Willis-Dowdell (Vice 13 President: and 14 Whereas, Over the last 70 years, the South Bend Alumnae 15 Chapter has significantly impacted the Michiana community by 16 raising and distributing thousands of dollars in scholarship 17 funds for young women to attend college, conducting 18 symposiums on addiction, Black maternal and infant health, 19 and breast cancer, hosting "Get Out the Vote" drives, and 20 organizing numerous health fairs to provide free flu and 21 COVID-19 vaccine shots: Therefore, 22 Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the 23 General Assembly of the State of Indiana: 24 SECTION 1. That the Indiana House of Representatives 25 celebrates the 70th anniversary of the Delta Sigma Theta 26 Sorority, Inc., South Bend Chapter. 27 SECTION 2.
