1 A HOUSE RESOLUTION honoring Representative Sue
2 Errington.

3 *Whereas, Representative Sue Errington, who began her*
4 *representation of House District 34 in 2012, will be retiring*
5 *from office in 2026;*

6 *Whereas, Prior to becoming a state representative,*
7 *Representative Errington served on the Delaware County*
8 *Council from 1993 to 1996 and in the Indiana State Senate for*
9 *District 26 from 2006 to 2010. She taught Spanish at Bethany*
10 *College in West Virginia, Anderson University, and Ball State*
11 *University;*

12 *Whereas, Representative Errington worked for Planned*
13 *Parenthood of Indiana and Kentucky for 17 years, serving as*
14 *Associate Director and Director of Public Policy during her*

2 *Whereas, During her time in the House of Representatives,*
3 *Representative Errington has served as the ranking minority*
4 *member of the Environmental Affairs Committee, as a member*
5 *of the Elections and Apportionment Committee, as Vice Chair*
6 *of the Statutory Committee on Ethics, and as a House ex officio*
7 *advisory member of the Recycling Market Development Board;*

8 *Whereas, Representative Errington has been heavily*
9 *involved in public service on local boards and commissions, as*
10 *well as with local, state, and national organizations advancing*
11 *women's rights and good government. She has been a member*
12 *of the National Caucus of Environmental Legislators since*
13 *2012, serving as the state lead from 2022 to 2024. She is also*
14 *a member of Women in Government, serving as director from*
15 *2008 to 2010, and the National Organization for Women,*
16 *working across multiple local, state, and national chapters. She*
17 *serves on the boards of directors of Muncie OUTreach, the*
18 *Delaware County Tobacco Free Coalition, the*
19 *Muncie/Delaware County Coalition of Women's Organizations,*
20 *and the Second Harvest Food Bank. Representative Errington*
21 *also serves as a board member of the Afghan Women's and*
22 *Kids' Education & Necessities (AWAKEN) organization and the*
23 *Indiana Recycling Market Development Program through the*
24 *Indiana Department of Environmental Management;*

25 *Whereas, Representative Errington has received a multitude*
26 *of awards for her dedicated public service, including the*
27 *inaugural Persistence Award from Muncie Resists, the*
28 *Outstanding Service to the Community Award from Muncie*
29 *OUTreach, and the John E. Worthen Outstanding Contribution*
30 *to Education Award from the Indiana Academy. She has also*
31 *been honored with the Athena Award from Women in Business*
32 *Unlimited, Woman of the Year from the Indiana National*
33 *Organization for Women, and both the Who's Who of Emerging*
34 *Leaders in America and Who's Who of American Women*
35 *awards. Additionally, she received the Perham Women of*
36 *Achievement Award for Distinction in Public Advocacy, among*
37 *many others;*
