MR. SPEAKER:

I move that Engrossed Senate Bill 1 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 1, between the enacting clause and line 1, begin a new
- 2 paragraph and insert:
- 3 "SECTION 1. IC 4-12-1-11.3 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA
- 4 CODE AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS
- 5 [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE]: **Sec. 11.3. At each meeting of the**
- 6 **budget committee, the budget committee shall review the amount**
- 7 **of federal funds available to the state and how any changes, or**
- 8 **potential changes, impact the state budget, the balance of the state**
- 9 **general fund, the state's combined reserve balance and surplus**
- 10 **money, and the state's ability to adequately provide programs and**
- 11 **services to the citizens of Indiana."**
- 12 Page 1, between lines 11 and 12, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 13 "SECTION 3. IC 4-12-1-23.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA
- 14 CODE AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS
- 15 [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE]: **Sec. 23.5. (a) The budget agency**
- 16 **shall closely monitor the amount of federal funds available to the**
- 17 **state and how any changes, or potential changes, impact the state**
- 18 **budget, the balance of the state general fund, the state's combined**
- 19 **reserve balance and surplus money, and the state's ability to**
- 20 **adequately provide programs and services to the citizens of**
- 21 **Indiana.**

1 **(b) The budget agency shall determine, as necessary, but at least**
 2 **one (1) time not later than the last day of each month, whether a**
 3 **transfer from the state's combined reserve balance is necessary to**
 4 **restore any amount of funding needed for state programs or**
 5 **services as a result of any decreases in federal funding, including**
 6 **funding for the following:**

7 **(1) Public education, including decreases in Title 1 federal**
 8 **funding and special education funding.**

9 **(2) The national guard.**

10 **(3) Health care services and the provision of health care.**

11 **(4) Agriculture.**

12 **(5) Veterans' services.**

13 **(6) Food assistance.**

14 **(7) Housing assistance.**

15 **(8) Transportation.**

16 **(9) Utility assistance.**

17 **(10) Child care.**

18 **(11) Tariff relief.**

19 **The budget agency may, following a determination by the budget**
 20 **agency and review by the budget committee, transfer funds in the**
 21 **state's combined reserve balance to augment and supplement any**
 22 **funds previously appropriated for state programs or services as is**
 23 **determined necessary.**

24 **(c) The budget agency shall provide a report concerning the**
 25 **information described in subsection (a) to the budget committee at**
 26 **each meeting of the budget committee, including any determination**
 27 **that has been made concerning the need for supplemental funding.**

28 **(d) There is appropriated from the state's combined reserve**
 29 **balance in each state fiscal year beginning after June 30, 2025, and**
 30 **ending before July 1, 2027, to the budget agency, to be transferred**
 31 **as needed according to a determination described in subsection (b),**
 32 **an amount sufficient to be used for the purpose of restoring any**
 33 **additional amount of funding needed for state programs or services**
 34 **as a result of any decreases in federal funding.**

35 **(e) This section expires July 1, 2027."**

36 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
