

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

SB 1 # 14

DIGEST

Medicaid eligibility. Provides that the office of the secretary of family and social services may not apply to the United States Department of Health and Human Services for any amendment to the Medicaid state plan or a Medicaid waiver, or request approval in any other manner, to change the definition of "medically frail" for purposes of the Medicaid program from the definition in effect on January 1, 2026, until any proposed change in the definition of "medically frail" is reviewed by the budget committee.

- 1 Page 7, between lines 37 and 38, begin a new paragraph and insert:
2 "SECTION 10. IC 12-15-1.3-26.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA
3 CODE AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS
4 [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE]: **Sec. 26.5. The office may not**
5 **apply to the United States Department of Health and Human**
6 **Services for any amendment to the Medicaid state plan or a**
7 **Medicaid waiver, or request approval in any other manner, to**
8 **change the definition of "medically frail" for purposes of the**
9 **Medicaid program from the definition in effect on January 1, 2026,**
10 **until any proposed change in the definition of "medically frail" is**
11 **reviewed by the budget committee."**
12 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
