

# PROPOSED AMENDMENT

## SB 4 # 10

### DIGEST

Home and community based services waiver. Requires the office of the secretary of family and social services to apply to the United States Department of Health and Human Services for an amendment to each home and community based services Medicaid waiver to use a specified asset limit threshold when determining an individual's eligibility for services under a home and community based services Medicaid waiver.

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- 1           Page 3, between lines 38 and 39, begin a new paragraph and insert:  
2           "SECTION 4. IC 12-15-1.3-18.8 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA  
3           CODE AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS  
4           [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2026]: **Sec. 18.8. (a) Before September 1,**  
5           **2026, the office of the secretary shall apply to the United States**  
6           **Department of Health and Human Services for an amendment to**  
7           **each home and community based services Medicaid waiver to,**  
8           **when determining an individual's eligibility for a home and**  
9           **community based services Medicaid waiver, use an asset limit**  
10          **threshold as follows:**  
11                **(1) For a single individual, five thousand dollars (\$5,000).**  
12                **(2) For a married individual, ten thousand dollars (\$10,000).**  
13                **(b) The office of the secretary shall implement the changes in**  
14                **determining eligibility for a home and community based services**  
15                **Medicaid waiver specified in subsection (a) beginning on the date**  
16                **on which the United States Department of Health and Human**  
17                **Services approves the request for changes by the office of the**  
18                **secretary under this section."**  
19                Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
