MR. SPEAKER:

*Your Committee on Public Policy, to which was referred Senate Bill 5, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the House with the recommendation that said bill **be amended** as follows:*

- 1 Page 2, delete line 42, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 2 "SECTION 3. IC 7.1-3-23-7.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA
- 3 CODE AS A **NEW SECTION** TO READ AS FOLLOWS
- 4 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2026]: **Sec. 7.5. (a) The chairman of the**
- 5 **commission may suspend an alcoholic beverage retail permit**
- 6 **without advance notice or a hearing for a period of not longer than**
- 7 **three (3) business days if all of the following apply:**
- 8 **(1) The chairman has a reasonable belief that a felony has**
- 9 **been committed on the licensed premises.**
- 10 **(2) The permit holder failed to take reasonable action to**
- 11 **prevent the occurrence of a crime.**
- 12 **(3) Multiple crimes or violations have occurred on the**
- 13 **licensed premises in the last twelve (12) months.**

- 1 **(4) The continued operation of the licensed premises would**
- 2 **pose a clear and immediate danger to the safety of the**
- 3 **surrounding community or general public.**
- 4 **(b) Upon the suspension of a permit under subsection (a), the**
- 5 **commission shall:**
- 6 **(1) give immediate notice to the permittee of:**
- 7 **(A) a factual basis for the suspension; and**
- 8 **(B) the time and place of a hearing on the suspension; and**
- 9 **(2) hold the hearing not later than three (3) business days**
- 10 **after the permit is suspended.**
- 11 **(c) The commission is not required to consider or prove the**
- 12 **factors in subsection (a) to declare a public nuisance under**
- 13 **IC 7.1-2-6."**
