**Summary of Legislation:** (Amended) This bill provides that a public utility provide notice to the public, affected landowners, the county plan commission, and on the public utility's web site, if any, before it condemns land for the purpose of extending a water or wastewater main. It requires a public utility to schedule a meeting with a landowner or interested party not later than 30 days after receiving a request for a meeting.
