A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning elections.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1	SECTION 1. IC 3-5-2.1-87.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA
2	CODE AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS
3	[EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2026]: Sec. 87.5. "Ranked choice voting"
4	refers to a system of voting that:
5	(1) allows a voter to rank to each candidate on a ballot for a
6	particular office in an order of preference; and
7	(2) tabulates each ballot in multiple rounds following the
8	elimination of a candidate;
9	until a single candidate receives a majority of the votes cast.
10	SECTION 2. IC 3-5-4-16 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
11	AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
12	1, 2026]: Sec. 16. The following apply to an election conducted
13	under this title:
14	(1) An election may not be determined by ranked choice
15	voting.
16	(2) A candidate may not be nominated for or elected to an
17	office by means of ranked choice voting.
