A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning general provisions.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

1        SECTION 1. IC 1-2-18 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE AS  
2        A **NEW CHAPTER** TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY  
3        1, 2026]:  
4        **Chapter 18. State Sandwich**  
5        **Sec. 1. The breaded tenderloin sandwich, made from Indiana**  
6        **raised pork, is designated as the official state sandwich of Indiana.**
