<u>Summary of Legislation:</u> This bill allows the Alcohol and Tobacco Commission to issue a permit for the sale of alcoholic beverages on the grounds of a county fair conducted by a local board, subject to certain limitations and requirements.

Effective Date: July 1, 2026.

Explanation of State Expenditures: The bill would increase the workload of the Alcohol and Tobacco Commission to issue permits to a local board for a county fair. The workload increase can likely be done within current resources.
