**Summary of Legislation:** This bill allows the Alcohol and Tobacco Commission to issue a permit for the sale of alcoholic beverages on the grounds of a county fair conducted by a local board, subject to certain limitations and requirements.

**Effective Date:** July 1, 2026.

**Explanation of State Expenditures:** The bill would increase the workload of the Alcohol and Tobacco Commission to issue permits to a local board for a county fair. The workload increase can likely be done within current resources.
