**Summary of Legislation:** The bill specifies that if there is more than one candidate for a school board office within certain designated groups of candidates, the candidates shall appear in a certain order and within the grouping and in alphabetical order according to surname.

**Effective Date:** Upon passage.

**Explanation of State Expenditures:** The Election Division may need to update certain publications of to notify county election boards of the bill's proposed changes. It is likely the Division would be able to make changes when updating these publications as routine administrative business.
