## SENATE BILL No. 51

## DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 12-15-5-6.5.

**Synopsis:** Postpartum care for new mothers on Medicaid. Requires that: (1) certain health care providers; (2) hospitals; and (3) the office of the secretary of family and social services or a managed care organization that has contracted with the office under the Medicaid program; ensure that a Medicaid recipient or an individual eligible for Medicaid who gives birth schedules a follow-up appointment for postpartum care that is not later than 60 days from the date the woman gives birth. (The introduced version of this bill was prepared by the interim study committee on public health, behavioral health, and human services.)

Effective: July 1, 2026.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning health.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

3	1,2026]: Sec. 6.5. The following shall ensure that a woman who has
4	given birth and is either a Medicaid recipient or eligible for
5	Medicaid schedules a follow-up appointment with a health care
6	provider for a postpartum checkup that is not later than sixty (60)
7	days from the date the woman gives birth:
8	(1) A hospital that is licensed under IC 16-21 and operates a
9	maternity unit.
10	(2) A health care provider that provided prenatal or delivery
11	care to the woman.
12	(3) The office or a managed care organization that has
13	contracted with the office under this article.
