DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 12-7-2; IC 12-17.2-3.8.

Synopsis: Kindergarten readiness indicators. Requires the early learning advisory committee to establish and publish kindergarten readiness indicators (indicators). Establishes requirements regarding the indicators, including publication of the indicators on a single and easy to access website page. Requires the department of education, the office of early childhood and out of school learning, and the Indiana department of health to display on certain website pages a link to the indicator web page.

Effective: July 1, 2026.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning human services.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

12	(1) behavioral well-being development;
13	(2) approaches to learning and executive function;
14	(3) language and early literacy;
15	(4) early mathematics and problem solving;
16	(5) physical health and motor development; and
17	(6) communication and relationships;

11	(c) In establishing and publishing the kindergarten readiness
12	indicators, the committee shall ensure the following:
13	(1) Indiana's early learning standards and existing definitions
14	and the indicators are aligned.
15	(2) The indicators are written in clear, plain language for
16	families, educators, and caregivers.
17	(3) The indicators reflect input from early education
18	providers, kindergarten through grade 3 educators, parents,
19	employers, and community organizations.
20	(4) The indicators support and do not conflict with existing
21	health, development, and early learning rules or guidance
22	issued by state agencies (as defined in IC 1-1-15-3).
23	SECTION 4. IC 12-17.2-3.8-6.7 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA
24	CODE AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS
25	[EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2026]: Sec. 6.7. (a) The committee shall
26	publish the kindergarten readiness indicators as follows:
27	(1) The indicators must be published on a single and easy to
28	access website page.
29	(2) The website page described in subdivision (1) must be
30	entitled "Kindergarten Readiness Roadmap".
31	(3) The indicators must be available on the website page
32	described in subdivision (1) as printable one (1) page
33	summaries that contain the indicators for each of the
34	following age bands:
35	(A) Birth through one (1) year of age.
36	(B) One (1) through two (2) years of age.
37	(C) Two (2) through three (3) years of age.
38	(D) Three (3) through four (4) years of age.
39	(E) Four (4) through five (5) years of age.
40	(b) The department of education, the office of early childhood
41	and out of school learning, and the Indiana department of health
42	shall prominently display a link to the website page described in

13	[EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2026]: Sec. 6.9. In carrying out sections 6.5
14	and 6.7 of this chapter, the committee and the agencies listed in
15	section 6.7(b) of this chapter:
16	(1) may not create new standalone programs or duplicative
17	materials if existing resources can be updated to reflect the
18	kindergarten readiness indicators; and
19	(2) shall, to the extent practicable, do the following:
20	(A) Use existing:
21	(i) staff, resources, and technology; and
22	(ii) applicable federal, state, private, or philanthropic
23	funds.
24	(B) Use and adapt, as applicable, existing publications
25	digital platforms, and partnerships
