<u>Summary of Legislation:</u> The bill requires certain drive-through facilities constructed or renovated after December 31, 2026, to have a separate bypass lane adjacent to the specified drive-through lanes. It makes certain exceptions. The bill requires the Fire Prevention and Building Safety Commission to adopt administrative rules.

Effective Date: July 1, 2026.

**Explanation of State Expenditures:** The bill would increase workload and/or expenditures for the Fire Prevention and Building Safety Commission. The bill requires the commission to adopt administrative rules and review orders for denied exemptions. Revenue from the Fire and Building Services Fund is used to fund operations of the Fire Prevention and Building Safety Commission at the Department of Homeland Security.
