MR. SPEAKER:

I move that Engrossed Senate Bill 76 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 12, after line 42, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 2 **"Sec. 13. (a) The economic and employment impact of**
- 3 **immigration enforcement task force is established.**
- 4 **(b) Except as otherwise provided in this section, the task force**
- 5 **is subject to IC 2-5-1.2.**
- 6 **(c) The task force consists of the following eleven (11) members:**
- 7 **(1) Two (2) members of the house of representatives**
- 8 **appointed by the speaker of the house of representatives.**
- 9 **(2) Two (2) members of the house of representatives**
- 10 **appointed by the minority leader of the house of**
- 11 **representatives.**
- 12 **(3) Two (2) members of the senate appointed by the president**
- 13 **pro tempore of the senate.**
- 14 **(4) Two (2) members of the senate appointed by the minority**
- 15 **leader of the senate.**
- 16 **(5) One (1) lay member representing the Indiana Farm**
- 17 **Bureau appointed by the chair of the legislative council.**
- 18 **(6) One (1) lay member representing the Indiana Chamber of**
- 19 **Commerce appointed by the vice chair of the legislative**
- 20 **council.**
- 21 **(7) One (1) lay member representing the Indiana Builders**
- 22 **Association appointed by the legislative council.**

- 1 **The members must be appointed before July 15, 2026.**
- 2 **(d) The speaker of the house of representatives shall designate**
3 **the chair of the task force from the members appointed under**
4 **subsection (c)(1). The president pro tempore of the senate shall**
5 **designate the vice chair of the task force from the members**
6 **appointed under subsection (c)(3).**
- 7 **(e) The task force shall meet at least five (5) times during its**
8 **operation. A meeting may not occur less than one (1) month after**
9 **the previous meeting.**
- 10 **(f) A vacancy must be filled in the same manner as the original**
11 **appointment.**
- 12 **(g) The task force shall do the following:**
- 13 **(1) Investigate, review, and report the following information**
14 **for calendar years 2025, 2026, and 2027:**
- 15 **(A) The annual total of businesses operating in Indiana and**
16 **broken out separately for at least the following categories:**
- 17 **(i) Farms.**
18 **(ii) Agribusiness.**
- 19 **(B) The number of total business bankruptcies in Indiana**
20 **and broken out separately for at least the following**
21 **categories:**
- 22 **(i) Farms.**
23 **(ii) Agribusiness.**
- 24 **(C) The change in the average cost of labor in Indiana and**
25 **broken out separately for at least the following categories:**
- 26 **(i) Farms.**
27 **(ii) Agribusiness.**
- 28 **(D) The change in consumer prices in Indiana and broken**
29 **out separately for at least the category of the cost of**
30 **groceries.**
- 31 **(E) The total economic contribution to Indiana's economy**
32 **of farms and agribusiness as reported by the Indiana state**
33 **department of agriculture.**
- 34 **(F) The change in annual exports of agricultural goods as**
35 **reported by the Indiana state department of agriculture.**
- 36 **(2) Not later than November 1, 2027, submit a final report**
37 **with findings and recommendations for legislation to do the**
38 **following:**
- 39 **(A) Improve the function of immigration enforcement in**
40 **Indiana to best support Indiana employers and economic**
41 **development.**
- 42 **(B) Support Indiana businesses.**
- 43 **(C) Support Indiana farmers and agribusinesses.**
- 44 **(D) Improve the structure of Indiana's economic**
45 **development system.**

- 1 **(h) The legislative services agency shall staff the task force.**
- 2 **(i) This section expires December 31, 2027."**
