

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

SB 78 # 5

DIGEST

Wireless communication device policy. Removes a provision concerning the return of wireless communication devices upon a student's dismissal at the end of the school day. Permits a secure storage policy under which wireless communication devices may be brought to school, but must be stored away and inaccessible to a student throughout the school day, except for passing periods. Provides that a wireless communication device policy implemented by each school corporation and charter school may not prohibit a student from using a wireless communication device during the school day if the use of the device is necessary for the management of a documented medical condition pursuant to an order provided by a health care provider who is licensed in Indiana.
