Summary of Legislation: This bill addresses unresolved amend-repeal conflicts created during the 2025 legislative session. It repeals and relocates the specific definitions chapters for organization of defined terms by alphabetical order and to provide for future expansion of those chapters. It makes conforming cross-reference updates. It resolves technical conflicts between SB 80-2025 and HB 1088-2025 (the annual Technical Corrections bill) and technical conflicts between various enrolled acts passed during the 2026 legislative session. The bill also makes no substantive change to law.

Effective Date: Upon passage; July 1, 2026; January 1, 2027; July 1, 2027; January 1, 2028; July 1, 2028.
