SENATE BILL No. 87

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning labor and safety.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 22-5-1.7-11.1, AS ADDED BY P.L.252-2015,
2 SECTION 32, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
3 JULY 1, 2026]: Sec. 11.1. **(a)** This section applies only to a contract for
4 a public works project entered into or renewed after June 30, 2015, **and**
5 **before July 1, 2026.** A public agency may not enter into or renew a
6 contract for a public works project with a contractor unless:
7 (1) the contract contains:
8 (A) a provision requiring the contractor to enroll in and
9 verify the work eligibility status of all newly hired
10 employees of the contractor through the E-Verify program;
11 and
12 (B) a provision that provides that a contractor is not
13 required to verify the work eligibility status of all newly
14 hired employees of the contractor through the E-Verify
15 program if the E-Verify program no longer exists; and

(2) the contractor signs an affidavit affirming that the contractor does not knowingly employ an unauthorized alien.

(b) This section applies only to a contract for a public works project under IC 4-13.6, IC 5-16, IC 5-23-4, IC 5-30, or IC 5-32 entered into or renewed after June 30, 2026. A public agency may not enter into or renew a contract for a public works project with a contractor unless:

(1) the contract contains:

(A) a provision requiring the contractor to enroll in and verify the work eligibility status of all newly hired employees of the contractor through the E-Verify program; and

(B) a provision that provides that a contractor is not required to verify the work eligibility status of all newly hired employees of the contractor through the E-Verify program if the E-Verify program no longer exists; and

(2) the contractor signs a notarized affidavit affirming that the contractor does not knowingly employ an unauthorized alien.

SECTION 2. IC 22-5-1.7-11.2 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2026]: Sec. 11.2. (a) This section applies only to a public contract for services that is:

(1) entered into or renewed after June 30, 2026; and

(2) for a public works project under:

(A) IC 4-13.6;

(B) IC 5-16;

(C) IC 5-23-4;

(D) IC 5-30;

(E) IC 5-32; or

(F) any other statute applicable to the public works of the public agency.

(b) A contractor for a public works project, including the general contractor, a construction manager, or CMc (as defined in IC 5-32-2-5), shall do the following:

(1) Before a contractor's employees begin work on a public works project do the following:

(A) Provide the person who hired the contractor a notarized affidavit affirming that the contractor does not knowingly employ an unauthorized alien.

(B) Enroll in and verify the work eligibility of all employees of the contractor working on the public



1 works project through the E-Verify program.
 2 (2) Upon request of the person who hired the contractor,
 3 provide an E-verification number for an individual who is:
 4 (A) employed by the contractor; and
 5 (B) working on the public works project;
 6 within three (3) business days of the request.
 7 (c) A contractor, including the general contractor, a
 8 construction manager, or CMc (as defined in IC 5-32-2-5), may not
 9 employ an individual for a public works project if:
 10 (1) the contractor has verified the individual's work
 11 eligibility through the E-verify program; and
 12 (2) the individual has no E-verification number.
 13 However, an individual may work on the project if the individual
 14 provides the contractor with a valid E-verification number any
 15 time after the initial verification.
 16 (d) A contractor, including the general contractor, a
 17 construction manager, or CMc (as defined in IC 5-32-2-5), acting
 18 in good faith who falsely identifies:
 19 (1) an unauthorized worker as an authorized worker; or
 20 (2) an authorized worker as an unauthorized worker;
 21 to comply with the provisions of this section is immune from civil
 22 liability with respect to the false identification.
 23 SECTION 3. IC 34-30-2.1-298.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA
 24 CODE AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS
 25 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2026]: Sec. 298.5. IC 22-5-1.7-11.2
