Summary of Legislation: This bill provides the Alcohol and Tobacco Commission may issue not more than three new three-way permits to the town of Schererville.

Effective Date: July 1, 2026.

Explanation of State Expenditures: The Alcohol and Tobacco Commission would have an increase in workload to issue the permits. This workload increase should be done within current resources.

Explanation of State Revenues: The bill adds up to 3 three-way permits for the town of Schererville. If all three permits are issued, the total initial fee revenue would be \$120,000. The revenue would be distributed as follows:

- \$44,400 to the General Fund,
- \$39,600 to the town, and
- \$36,000 to the Enforcement and Administration Fund.

The initial fee for these permits is \$40,000. The annual permit fee for a three-way permit is \$1,000. Revenue is distributed to the General Fund (37%); the city, town, or county in which the licensed premises are located (33%); and the Enforcement and Administration Fund (30%).

Explanation of Local Expenditures:

Explanation of Local Revenues: To the extent that revenue from permit fees increases, the amounts distributed to the town of Schererville would also increase. [See *Explanation of State Revenues.*]
