

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

SB 90 # 1

DIGEST

Informed consent and removal of disciplinary sanctions. Provides that informed consent does not have to be separate if the examination is within the scope of care for the surgical procedure or diagnostic examination to be performed. Changes the disclosure on the informed consent to include the individual performing or supervising the examination instead of disclosing the name of both individuals. Removes language specifying that a violation is subject to disciplinary sanctions.
