**Summary of Legislation:** The bill provides that when an individual files a notice of withdrawal listing an address different from the address on the individual's voter registration record, the individual's signature on the notice of withdrawal constitutes a request to the county voter registration office that the address on the individual's voter registration record be the same as the address on the notice of withdrawal.

**Effective Date:** July 1, 2026.

**Explanation of State Expenditures:** The Election Division may have a very minor increase in workload to forward any state legislative or statewide office notice of withdrawal to the appropriate county voter registration office (CVRO), if not currently forwarded.
